Maths

This half term we will be:

English

This half term we will be focusing on the book 'Neil Armstrong'. We will cover:

- Using the correct punctuation in sentences (capital letters, full stops, finger spaces)
- Forming letters correctly and knowing the letter names and sounds for each.
- Using adjectives to describe a character

You could help your child at home by:

- Give your child a sentence to write with capital letters and full stops.
- Read back sentences to make sure they make sense.

Science:

This half term we will:

Learn about the basic needs of humans for survival, including the importance of exercise, nutrition and good hygiene. We will learn how human offspring change over time into adulthood.

Art:

This half term we will:

We will learn about basic colour theory by studying the colour wheel and colour mixing. We will explore primary and secondary colours and how artist use colour in their artwork. We will learn how to talk about art and reflect on our own art work. We will use question stems and a word banks to help us.
